
The 4/4 Pattern of Prayer

A Model from Jesus: Matthew 6:9-13

UPWARD STROKE: REVERENCE "Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your Name"	DOWNWARD STROKE: RESPONSE "Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven"	INWARD STROKE: REQUESTS "Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our debts as we forgive our	OUTWARD STROKE: READINESS "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.	FINAL UPWARD STROKE: PRAISE "For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever.
Ask: Who is God? Prayers of Praise & Thanksgiving	Ask: How should I respond? Pause and listen, pray in response to God's will and invitation	debtors" Ask: What should I pray about? Pray with heartfelt requests around the themes of resources (spiritual, physical emotional) & relationships (your relationship with God and others)	Ask: Where do I go from here? Prayers of claiming God's promises to overcome the spiritual battles before us.	Amen." We conclude our time of prayer with the same way we began, a high note of praise!
